White Wine (75cl Btls)

- 1 J. Moreau & Fils Sauvignon 2018 , Pays D'OC (France).....£15**
This excellent white Wine created by J Moreau et Fils originates from the Vin de France area of France. made from Sauvignon Blanc grapes. , elegant and zesty, delicious with dishes featuring smoked salmon, tomatoes, asparagus, green herbs, goats' cheese or white fish.
- .2. Il Caggio Pinot Grigio (Italy).....£13**
This delicately refreshing dry white is lemon yellow color. On the palate, flavors of fresh green apple and citrus are balanced well by aromas of stone fruit.
- 3. South Island Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand).....£15**
This wine has rich tropical aromas of mango, melon, and ripe citrus. The wine is equally lush on the palate with excellent fruit concentration, lees and mineral derived texture and a long juicy finish.
- 4. Bodegas Castro Martin Albarino (Spain).....£18**
Albarino has a lovely juicy pear and white peach aromas and a distinctive lemony finish. Some can even taste the sea in the salty minerality. The soft fruit is offset with zesty acidity making this the perfect partner to seafood.
- 5 Oxford Landing Chardonnay (Australia).....£14**
A Delicious Chardonnay packed with enticing fruit aromas and summer stone fruits. Generous, yet with finesse and elegance.
- 6 Fat Bastard Chardonnay (France).....£13**
A rich, golden yellow colour with complex aromas of vanilla and honeysuckle layered with subtle nuances of oak. On the palate, this wine has a full body with an eruption of tropical fruit flavour's that develop into a long, toasty finish. Food Pairing Pairs perfectly with friends, family, and flavourful seafood dishes including baked salmon and grilled tuna steaks
- 7 Halfway Sauvignon Blanc (South Africa)£14**
Dazzling fresh Cape Sauvignon from a highly awarded family property. South Africa has gained a terrific reputation for its super zingy Sauvignons and Halfway is a clear indication why. It sings out with bright tropical fruit and a crisp elegance.

Sparkling & Champagne

- 8. Orsala Prosecco.....£14**
Fine, persistent, soft fizz surrounds the typical fruit spectrum of apples, pears with a hint of peach.
- 9. Bollinger Champagne.....£36**
Bollinger is famous for its consistency of style, structure and aromatic complexity. This is a complex and elegant Champagne with a wonderful combination of velvety bubbles and flavours of pear, brioche, spice and fresh walnuts.
- 10. Laurent Perrier Brut Champagne.....£36**
With its composition marked by a high percentage of Chardonnay, Laurent-Perrier Brut is the signature House style, offering freshness, lightness and elegance, consistently showcasing the essential qualities sought by Laurent-Perrier.
- 11. Veuve Cliquot Brut.....£35**
The strength of this golden-yellow wine is immediately pleasing to the nose while its complexity explodes on the palate. The initial notes of fruit are followed by more discreet aromas of brioche and vanilla when the wine is allowed to age in the bottle. Brut Carte Jaune offers a perfect balance of finesse and forcefulness.
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Red Wine (75cl Btls)

- 12. Wyndham Estate Shiraz Bin 555 (Australia).....£14**
Medium to full bodied traditional Shiraz with distinct, rich plum and pepper characters. Parcels of the ripe fruit flavors are complexed by oak tannins.
- 13. Moulin De La Hargue Médoc Bordeaux 2016 (France).....£19**
You will enjoy the clean red fruit aromas, the silky structure and smooth tannins. Good harmony with very simple lightly seasoned food.
- 14. Campo Viejo Rioja Tempranillo (Spain).....£14**
A cherry red colour, suggestive of a vibrant Tempranillo wine. On the nose, it's rich aromas have a pronounced intensity with an initial scent of ripe red and spices..
- 15. Oyster Bay Pinot Noir (New Zealand).....£15**
Delightful fruit aromas of strawberry and redcurrant lead into tantalising savoury flavours of roast game, beetroot and raspberry. Soft tannins and a touch of acidity make it fresh on the palate.
- 16. Halfway Merlot (South Africa).....£14**
Smooth, juicy and ripely fruity Merlot from a highly awarded family property. This creamy smooth, plum rich red is the ultimate in drinkability. A simple, no-nonsense red that is as enjoyable on its own as it is with your weekday supper.
- 17. La Forge Pinot Noir Reserve (France).....£19**
A complex medium to full bodied wine with red fruit blackcurrant & cherry aromas with spicy notes and a hint of vanilla.
- 18. Chiliner Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile).....£13**
Our Cabernet Sauvignon has a rich and concentrated ruby-red color. The smell has blackcurrant and black cherries. Elegant with good balance. Its tannins are soft and mature.
- 19. El Supremo Malbec (Argentina).....£15**
Aromas of intense ripe fruit; cherries, blackberries, blueberries and fresh plums, combined with spicy floral hint. In the mouth the sweet and round tannins increase its fruit sensation and balance. Wine for good intensity, concentration and a long supple after taste. An Ideal partner for any rich meat dish.
- 20. LB7 Vinho Lisboa 2017 (Portugal).....£13**
Spicy bramble fruits of the forest red with a little oak to give it a rounded vanilla softened this is a super delicious silky smooth creation using local varieties.
- 21. Chateau Astrelus Merlot 2014 (France)£17**
Full flavored and complex in structure bursting with dark fruit flavors, it reveals aromas of cassis, and generous flavors of plum, black cherry and chocolate, complimented by smooth tannins.

Rose Wine (75cl Btls)

- 22. Mateus Rose (Portugal).....£13**
An attractive light pink colour with a fresh grapey nose and distinct varietal characteristics. The sweet rosé wine is a particularly well balanced fresh, light and fruity wine.
- 23. Yealands Sauvignon Blanc Blush (Australia).....£14**
A rich style of rose produced from softly pressed shiraz grapes. It features juicy cherry and strawberry flavours, supple textured tannins and a spicy, fresh finish.
- 24. Gallo White Grenache Rose (California).....£12**
This is a medium-sweet wine featuring flavours of jammy strawberry layered with sweet aromatics. Notes of bright red fruit and citrus lend to a balanced acidity for a clean, refreshing finish
- 25. Fat Bastard Rose 2016 (France).....£12**
A clear salmon colour in the glass, this value-priced rosé opens with attractive notes of white flowers, strawberry and peach, with the faintest hint of white chocolate in the back. Despite the rich, ripe aromas, the mouthfeel is lightweight and well balanced by ample orangy acidity.
