



2024 Autumn Wine List

White Wine (75cl Btls)

- 1. Tokomaru Bay Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand).....£20**
A sophisticated Sauvignon Blanc with intense aromas of ripe tropical fruit and hints of gooseberries, accompanied by vibrant acidity and a clean finish.
- 2. Santa Digna Sauvignon Blanc (Chile).....£18**
This wine is a fresh pale gold colour and has harmonious aromas recalling ripe tropical fruits layered over notes of apple and fennel. It is silky on the palate, with good acidic structure and a long finish.
- 3. Il Caggio Pinot Grigio (Italy).....£17**
This delicately refreshing dry white is lemon yellow color. On the palate, flavors of fresh green apple and citrus are balanced well by aromas of stone fruit.
- 4 Boschendal 1685 Chardonnay (France).....£18**
Big on aroma and flavours, combining a lemony, cinnamon, nutmeg nose with zesty citrus and ripe tropical fruit on the palate. Well balanced, the soft, buttery character adds to the complexity and roundness of the wine.
- 5 Foundstone Unoaked Chardonnay (Australia)£16**
Its elegant lines are echoed in this unoaked Chardonnay, the grapes for which were handpicked and cold fermented. The wine shows pure fruit intensity, with attractive pineapple and citrus notes balanced by a lively acidity.
- 6. . Esk Valley Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand).....£19**
This wine has rich tropical aromas of mango, melon, and ripe citrus. The wine is equally lush on the palate with excellent fruit concentration, lees and mineral derived texture and a long juicy finish.
- 7. Raimat Saira Albarino (Spain).....£19**
A Delicious Chardonnay packed with enticing fruit aromas and summer stone fruits. Generous, yet with finesse and elegance.
- 8. Whales Tale Saivion Blanc (New Zealand).....£19**
The Whale's Tale Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand's Marlborough is a crisp, fresh wine. In this wine you can taste passion fruit, lime, grapefruit, green herbs and freshly cut grass. Serve with salads or in combination with fish dishes.

Sparkling & Champagne

- 8. Orsala Prosecco.....£19**
Fine, persistent, soft fizz surrounds the typical fruit spectrum of apples, pears with a hint of peach.

 - 9. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV Champagne.....£49**
On the nose: yellow and white fruits, then notes of vanilla and later of brioche. On the palate: freshness and strength while pear and lemon tastes appear. Finish: admirably vinous. The lingering aromas echo and re-echo, with each fruit or almond notes distinct. Ideal as an aperitif, and ideal as the Champagne to enjoy with a meal.
 - 10. Moët & Chandon 'Brut Impérial' Champagne.....£50**
Moët is the ultimate celebratory fizz. The house is credited with inventing the Champagne glass pyramid. The victorious 'spray' of Champagne familiar to sport podiums is also down to them. But not only does their famous label put you in a party mood – it's also a fantastic wine. It's crisp and refreshing, but rich and ripe and full of stone fruit flavours. Think peach and lemon zest. With aromas of biscuit and brioche, it's as decadent as it is moreish. In 2022, this wine won an IWC award.

Red Wine (75cl Btls)

12. Torres Sangre Rioja (Spain).....£17

In sight it looks a ruby red color of medium layer. Fruity nose where the aromas of currants and blackberries stand out on a delicate floral background. Fresh entry in the mouth, with a long and persistent journey culminating in a soft and pleasant finish.

13. Camarada Malbec (Argentina)£18

Expect rich blackberry and blueberry flavours, complimented by hints of dark chocolate, vanilla and spice.

14 .Nine Stones Shiraz (Australia).....£18

Full bodied and intensely aromatic wine of plums, black fruit and blue berries and subtle oak complexity, great length and a long satisfying finish.

15. Dark Horse Merlot (California USA).....£17

Full-bodied and distinctive, each sumptuous glass of Dark Horse Merlot is layered with characteristics, where hints of toasted oak are married with dark berry notes - satisfyingly complex, yet tastefully balanced, this is a treat for the taste buds.

16. Graffigna Reserve Malbec (Argentina).....£17

Elegant and intense, this bold and fruit-forward wine has red berry notes balanced by a hint of black pepper. Paired with red meat, it makes for a moment of Greatness.

17. Chateau Le Barry Saint Eimilion (France).....£21

Chateau Le Barry has a steady garnet-red robe, an elegant high quality and rich nose with aromas of gingerbread, vanilla and ripe fruit. Perfect wit red meat, poultry or a cheese board.

18.Volandas Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile).....£17

Our Cabernet Sauvignon has a rich and concentrated ruby-red color. The smell has blackcurrant and black cherries. Elegant with good balance. Its tannins are soft and mature.

19. Carnivor Zinfandel 2019 (California USA).....£18

Meat was made for Carnivor. Our boldly blended Zinfandel is a captivating complement to your favourite red meat, layered with notes of dark cherry, blackberry jam, and perfectly toasted oak. Indulge your primal side with a glass of Carnivor and a juicy Steak.

20. Chateau Astrelus Merlot 2014 (France)£23

Full flavored and complex in structure bursting with dark fruit flavors, it reveals aromas of cassis, and generous flavors of plum, black cherry and chocolate, complimented by smooth tannins.

21.Chateauneuf Du Pape (France).....£41

Deep red in colour and offers a bouquet of small red berries and spices. It is the perfect

Rose Wine (75cl Btls)

22. Mateus Rose (Portugal).....£16

An attractive light pink colour with a fresh grapey nose and distinct varietal characteristics. The sweet rosé wine is a particularly well balanced fresh, light and fruity wine.

23. Sutter Home White Zinfandel (Australia).....£16

A rich style of rose produced from softly pressed shiraz grapes. It features juicy cherry and strawberry flavours, supple textured tannins and a spicy, fresh finish.

24. Gallo White Grenache Rose (California).....£16

This is a medium-sweet wine featuring flavours of jammy strawberry layered with sweet aromatics. Notes of bright red fruit and citrus lend to a balanced acidity for a clean, refreshing finish
